Charcoal portrait of Guy de Maupassant, shown in bust form, by Claude Weisbuch (1927-2014). Work done on studio paper, presented in its frame under glass. Signed and titled by the artist. 53 × 45 cm (framed). This work was acquired from an exhibition gallery in the 1990s and has remained in a private collection ever since. Claude Weisbuch's passion for literature is well known, as is his deep admiration for the writer Guy de Maupassant. In 1979, together with Maurice Genevoix (of the Académie Française), he illustrated an edition of Maupassant's *Le Horla*, of which 130 copies were printed. A versatile artist, Claude Weisbuch is particularly renowned for his nervous, expressive brushwork, as well as for his works full of movement around themes that are dear to him:
