Description

Superb, refined rug from Dagestan. Before discussing the aesthetic aspect of this piece, it's imperative to say a few words about its texture. The knotted stitch is almost microscopic, ultra-fine and tight. The piece is supple and light. This is indeed a characteristic of 19th-century Caucasian rugs. This structural aspect is amplified by the omnipresence of different indigo blues of great purity and infinite depth. The central field is composed of a series of successive rows of stylized anthropomorphic figures. Each cartouche seems precisely drawn, each detail bringing its own meaning. Beetles or stylized human figures. These are abstract representations of man in the tribal universe. There are also amulets and talismans as motifs of protection. The borders are made up of angular meanders, rosettes and hooks.
