Description

This glazed stoneware zoomorphic vase by Drôme artist Jacques Ibarra, born in 1929, is in perfect condition. This beautiful piece perfectly demonstrates the artist's technical mastery. It features a generous, stylized body, topped by a flared neck forming the bird's head, adorned with circular pastillé motifs in relief and geometric plumage. The tubular spout adds a playful touch. The wings and flat tail are highlighted by superb incised decoration in the material, contrasting magnificently with the off-white/shaded beige glaze typical of Mirmande workshop firings. The piece rests on a flared pedestal, ensuring perfect stability for this highly graphic silhouette, typical of the 1960s-1970s. Height: 25.5 cm. Length: 21 cm.
