All the ambiguity and humor of the composition reside in this comical situation, handled with great wit. The subject matter is inscribed on the wall of the room. The subject is in the tradition of libertine scenes inherited from the 16th century, much sought-after for their anecdotal character and narrative charm. The quality of the staging, the intimate atmosphere of the alcove and the deliberately mischievous character of the subject make it a particularly decorative work.
