Boch Kéramis Art Deco vase / Raymond Chevallier (active from 1937 to 1954 at Boch Kéramis) Epoque 1940 "Siren" model (D1437) with stylized waves and fish White enameled earthenware white and hand-painted gilded decoration Anses with four loops on the top and three loops on the bottom also hand-gilded Stamp (faint remains) and model number on the bottom of the vase: D1437 Illustrated in several books devoted to the productions of Boch Frères and also in Judith Miller's "L' ART DECO - l'oeil du chineur" (see photo). However, a dating error has crept into their text description... Example in fine overall condition, uncommon and quality!
