Marseille A marginal artist, he sold his canvases and drawings in cafés and restaurants and worked at night in friends' homes or some makeshift room. Surrounded by a solid group of friends, the Chave family, who housed and exhibited him, as well as the customers and proprietor of Café La Régence, Ozenda created a protean and inspired body of work, in which he laid bare his soul. He exhibited in Saint Paul de Vence, (where he remained until his death) : Galerie Alphonse Chave. In 1953, the gallery organized a solo show for him, "Un monde étrange de saints, de diables, de bêtes". This exhibition was followed by others (1955 1956 1959 1965 1966 1969 1972 1976). Ozenda took part in the "Peinture-lumière" exhibition, organized in Vallauris by André Verdet, in 1963. He died in 1976. After his death, retrospective exhibitions were devoted to him, in Paris, Lyon, Marseille ...
