### Description

Composition metal sculpture with red and gold patinas and gold, resting on a base of portor and onyx marble. A young girl with a boyish hairstyle and dressed simply in a red short dress is feeding seeds to doves sitting in front of her. The sculptor: Uriano, real name Ugo Cipriani, is the son of the son of sculptor Adolfo Cipriani. He was an Italian artist emblematic of the Art Deco movement, who moved to France in 1935 to escape Mussolini's fascist regime. His work is prolific, illustrated in particular by his famous "Diane chasseresse" and "Femme des années trente", often accompanied by deer, greyhounds and, here, doves.
