Oil on canvas. Signed lower left "J. Marec". Dimensions: 46 × 38 cm - with frame: 63 × 55 cm. In a Breton village street, the spire of a church stands out against a luminous blue sky. In the foreground, farmers in traditional dress bustle around cows, in the characteristic atmosphere of Breton livestock fairs. The crowd is dense, the silhouettes lively and the light sharp and contrasting. Jean Marec (1901-1972), a Breton painter, was a member of the Association des Peintres de Quimper Cornouaille. He devoted himself mainly to the scenes and landscapes of Brittany, faithfully capturing its lights and popular traditions. Presented in a fine carved gilded frame, in very good condition.
