Description

Rare decorative panel with gallant and libertine subjects dating from the late 19th century. This elegant composition takes the form of a large moving slab of griotte red marble, probably Italian, set in a bronze mount. In the center is a remarkable bronze in high relief with double patina depicting a couple dressed in 18th-century fashion in a gallant scene inspired by the libertine universe dear to the artists of the Louis XV century. The two figures are seated on a Rocaille-style chair and exchange a passionate kiss. The quality of the chasing allows us to appreciate numerous details: powdered hairstyles, jewelry, shoe buckles, trimmings, costume buttons and ornaments. The particularly lively modeling, combined with the nuanced gilding and burnished parts, gives the ensemble a remarkable
