Jules Paul Loebnitz, French ceramist, was born on August 5, 1836 in Paris. His father founded the Pichenot-Loebnitz factory in 1833. In 1857, Jules Loebnitz succeeded him as director of the earthenware factory, which mainly produced stoves and firebacks. From 1860 onwards, he began producing architectural ceramics. Beautiful earthenware plaque depicting a navy signed B. VERWAEST and dated 1880.
