A very elegant piece with fluted, detached column legs and guilloché brass uprights. It features three drawers in the front, framed by fine gilt brass stringing, highlighting the purity of the design. The feet are capped with bronze sabots, and the commode is finished with its original blue Turquin marble top. The locks, veneer, marble, and assembly are all original. It comes with its key.
