The front opens with a flap revealing an elegant interior fitted with small drawers, storage compartments and central drawer, typical of English secretaries of this period. The flap forms a writing case sheathed in antique leather with gilded decoration, offering a functional and refined workspace. The lower part opens with two large storage drawers in the front. The curved sides and slightly cambered legs bring a great deal of elegance to the ensemble. Very fine quality flame mahogany veneer in warm shades. Original bronze draw knobs and key escutcheons. This piece of furniture seduces with its sober, refined lines, characteristic of English furniture of the early XIXe century. It
