The flap sheathed in green leather gilded with small irons forms a writing desk, offering an elegant and functional workspace. The lower part opens with three drawers in the front adorned with floral marquetry in moving frames. The piece rests on cambered legs terminating in bronze sabots, and features an attractive decorative bronze trim on the front. Molded veined pink marble top following the shapes of the piece.
