A Louis XVI period lacquered chamber pot or commode chair. Circa 1780. Carved fluting, cane seat, tapered legs. Leather-wrapped armrests. Significant wear to the patina. H x W x D = 100 x 51 x 45 cm The Louis XV or Louis XVI chamber pot or commode chair is a fairly simple piece of furniture consisting of a wide apron to conceal the chamber pot. This commode chair has the characteristic curved lines of the style of the period. Its seat has a hole for the metal or ceramic chamber pot or basin. Sometimes a lid covers this opening to restore the chair to its simple function as a seat.
