



Spectacular Vermeil Monstrance - Circa 1840

Description

Our imposing monstrance is made entirely of vermeil and features a gilded metal lunette. The rocaille-style quadripod base is decorated with scrolls and acanthus leaves. It is adorned with the Lamb of the Apocalypse and vine branches. The angel Gabriel stands, arms crossed on a globe, surrounded by the snakesnake seeking the apple. The upper part is adorned with angel heads in clouds surrounded by glory and classically topped by the Cross. Presence of the Minerve hallmarks and those of the Parisian master goldsmiths MARTIN and DEJEAN, active between 1837 and 1846. A piece that would be at home in a cathedral. Height 92.5 cm, width 44 cm. Gross weight: 2370 grams Very good condition
