Traditional wooden statue from Western India, late 1800s. The statue served as a decorative element in a palace or nobleman's residence. The black markings on the hands and feet may represent a protective ritual, while the statue was carved from a single block of hardwood, most likely teak. The voluminous hairstyle, very typical of India, suggests a Western Indian origin, while the disc-shaped earrings and the pose are characteristic of the aristocratic culture of the period.
