Gonthier. Gonthier' lower rightGeorges Gonthier, trained by Prix de Rome winner Fortuné Layraud, pursued a career as an art teacher, specializing in landscape painting. In 1907, he became a drawing teacher in Fécamp, then moved to Le Havre in 1914, where he taught at the École Régionale des Beaux-Arts from 1924. His works mainly illustrate the landscapes of the North, Brittany, Savoy and the area around Le Havre.Our painting immortalizes a sunset over the countryside, highlighting chromatic work that lends all its intensity to the sky, adorned with clouds in pink and orange hues,
