Description

Learning about anatomy and the body is an essential part of academic education. Under the Empire, antique subjects were in fashion. Cropped from life, the athletic body of a model forced into a pose is captured here from the torso, holding his arm aloft, relieved by a strap to which he is clutching. The drawing is firm and precise, with no weaknesses, and the author masters his subject with a definite economy of means. Framed in an early 19th-century stick, the drawing is in very good condition.
