Pair of ormolu decorative ornaments, Louis XV style work, XIXe century. Elegant composition forming a pediment or element of architectural ornamentation, crafted in finely chased ormolu. The ensemble features a rich rocaille décor with scrolls, acanthus leaves and asymmetrical volutes typical of the Louis XV taste. The two symmetrical side elements are joined by a crosspiece adorned with a central foliate motif, offering a highly decorative and refined composition. High-quality chasing and attractive antique gilding with a warm patina. These ornaments could originally have adorned a cartel, a clock, a piece of furniture or served as wall decoration. Very beautiful decorative object that can be diverted in a classical, Baroque or eclectic interior. Era: XIXe
