Representing a Stand at the Liège Fair painted in 1952. Lucien De Rijcke (known as Luc, name often spelled De Rycke), 1899-1966, Belgian painter, draftsman, visual artist and cartonier born in Ghent. With a predilection for landscapes, urban views and still lifes, he produced both figurative and abstract works. He was also a decorator for the city of Ghent's two theaters.
