Description

Sèvres Porcelain sugar bowl, barrel shape, with lion's claw handles. Beautiful Egyptian-style decoration on a pink "hydrangea" background, featuring stylized lotus flowers on a white background, framed by gold fillets. In the center of the saucer, a rosette of stylized lotus flowers. The cup and saucer bear the Manufacture de Sèvres mark on the back: the double L of Louis XVIII, the Fleur de Lys Royale and the number and the number 21 for the year 1821. Gilded gilder's mark. Our service appears to be the original decoration, of which later variants with a polychrome flower frieze are known: - the original dessert service described as "pink background with colored frieze white zone" produced in 1822 and sold to Monsieur Holgan. - the "light frieze pink
