



## Dish From The Hoi An Shipwreck (15th Century)

### Description

Rare Vietnamese porcelain dish (porcelainous stoneware) from the shipwreck off the town of Hoi An. The edges are scalloped and the characteristic bottom is tinted in a spiral of iron-red slip. The cavetto shows a frieze of Yuan-style ruyi or linghzi heads, the central decoration a Chinese lion with its ball, amid clouds. The cover is still very shiny. In very good condition, apart from two very discreet small chips and a very small firing defect (photo 5). Diameter: 24.5 cm, weight: 895 g.
