Reverhorst (1720-1751) of the Dutch East India Company, with the eight arms of his grandparents depicted on the plate. Other pieces from this service are in the Metropolitan Museum in New York, the Rijksmuseum in Amsterdam and the Musée Guimet in Paris and the Lakenhal Museum, Leiden.

Very good condition, two very small chips to the edge and another imperfection to the glaze near them.
