Crimean War souvenir lighter, mid-19th century. An unusual military-related desk or cabinet souvenir, made in the form of a cannonball or grenade and raised on three ball feet. The upper section is fitted with a metal mount, and the body incorporates an inset Imperial Russian silver coin, likely of the Nicholas I period, circa 1830s-1840s. The object combines military symbolism with a functional or decorative smoking-related form, typical of commemorative objects associated with 19th-century conflicts. Period: Mid-19th century. Historical association: Crimean War period. Material: Metal, inset Imperial Russian silver coin. Coin: Imperial Russian silver coin, likely Nicholas I period, circa 1830s-1840s.
