Fedor van Kregten (1871-1937) was a Dutch painter belonging to the second generation of the Hague School. Born in Diever, Netherlands, he was largely self-taught and became known for his poetic landscapes, often depicting cattle, sheep and the Dutch countryside. His work bears witness to a deep attachment to nature and rural life. After several trips to Spain and Morocco his palette became brighter and more vividly colored, while retaining the peaceful atmosphere characteristic of his paintings. Today, Fedor van Kregten is recognized as a talented landscape painter
