JAPAN - Meiji period (1868-1912).KATANAKAKE in paulownia wood, the crosspiece openwork, one element glued back at the front right foot.This katanakake allows two swords or a shirasaya-mounted set to be displayed.The wakizashis shown as examples in the photographs are not sold with the katanakake.Dimensions : 38 x 44 x 22.5 cm.Notes : Paulownia (kiri in Japanese) has held an important place in Japanese decorative arts for centuries. Appreciated for the lightness and finesse of its wood, it is used in the manufacture of chests, lacquered boxes, furniture and handicrafts.
