The decoration is composed of Art Nouveau scrolls, organic floral motifs and gilded details on the neck as well as on the decoration. The piece has great charm, with a beautiful decorative presence and a style typical of the early 20th century. Legras is a famous French glassware house, renowned for its refined decorative creations. The factory, based in Saint-Denis, became famous in the late 19th and early 20th centuries for its artistic glass with floral decorations, landscapes, enamelled, engraved or acid-worked motifs.
