Important Empire period armchair in solid cherrywood, French work from the early XIXe century. This chair features an elegant, slightly curved back, upholstered in antique fabric highlighted by a tapestry nail finish. The bracketed armrests, with their sober, architectural lines, rest on uprights carved with foliate motifs characteristic of the decorative repertoire of the Empire period. The generous seat is upholstered in a fine antique fabric, highlighted by a tapestry nail finish. The generous, comfortable seat is part of a structure of harmonious proportions. The square-section legs are terminated by handsome bronze sabots, a refined detail testifying to the quality craftsmanship of this piece of furniture. The legs have a square cross-section. Made from solid cherrywood, this armchair seduces with its

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rich antique patina, noble lines and authenticity.

The structure is sound and stable. The antique strapping visible under the seat testifies to respect for its original construction.
