Description

Large, finely carved marble coat of arms surmounted by a knight's helmet and surrounded by rich, harmoniously curved mantling. The shield is composed of 3 fortified towers, a fleur-de-lys, stylized heads of putti blowing wind and a heraldic lion. These coats of arms, whose sculpted symbols, figures or colors identified a person or a family, or even a town, were used as decorative and architectural elements in buildings. Integrated into the masonry, they testified to the nobility and prestige of the family.

17th century (or prior) period coat-of-arms, showing some wear, chips and minor missing parts. Height 62cm 48.5 x 6cm
