Rare suite of six small vermeil spoons from the Consulat - Premier Empire period, preserved in its elegant original leather-wrapped case à la forme. These six spoons feature a sober, refined line characteristic of French production in the early XIXe century. The almond-shaped spoons are combined with plain handles with spatulate ends, each engraved with an antique monogram. They bear the guarantee hallmarks of the period, including the faisceau de lecteur de petite garantie. Particularly sought-after, the original case perfectly matches the shape of the spoons and is a rare testament to the art of living under the Consulate and First Empire.
