Flemish school circle of Gerard Seghers The Denial of Saint Peter 17th century oil on panel Oil on oak panel depicting the episode of the Denial of Saint Peter with three mid-body figures in a tight composition: the bearded apostle raising his hand in a gesture of denial, a turbaned maid and a soldier in armor holding a spear, a treatment characteristic of Antwerp Baroque with a contrasting palette and attention to expressions and drapery, a work closely associated with the circle of Gerard Seghers (1591-1651), presented in a gilded wood frame in the later Empire style. Details : Panel size : 17 × 23 cm - Weight : 773 g Technique : oil on oak panel Condition : old panel, age cracks, dirt and yellowed varnish, frame with wear.
