This still life depicts an arrangement of flowers and fruits resting on an undefined stone surface, set against a dark, uniform background that highlights and emphasizes the individual elements. The bumpy surface of the lemons, as well as the hollowed-out flesh of the watermelon, reflect light in a tactile way, as do the soft skins of the peaches or the hard rind of the pomegranate. The composition is comparable to contemporary 17th-century examples from the Lombard school, whose naturalistic influence is evident in the descriptive autonomy that is entirely unprecedented within the broader Italian artistic landscape.- All our works are accompanied by a detailed certificate
