Introduced to the art world as a child by his father, Maurice Mendjisky, a member of the Ecole de Paris, he trained at the Ecole des Beaux-Arts. He went on to make a name for himself through exhibitions in Europe, the United States and Japan. First focusing his career on painting, his style and technique brought him closer to the post-impressionist and pointillist painters. He then turned to photography as his main means of expression from the 2000s onwards, creating
