Description

This superb piece of French art history is a magnificent original oil painting by the renowned Salon artist Henri-Arthur Bonnefoy (1839-1917). Entitled "Les Fleurs", this work exemplifies the technical mastery that earned Bonnefoy his place at the prestigious Salon de Paris. Painted on oak panel - typical of fine 19th-century French work - the composition presents a sumptuous bouquet in the country style. Luminous white daisies and delicate pink field roses are enhanced by vibrant touches of violet flowers and golden buttercups. The brushwork is refined, capturing the delicate transparency of the petals against an atmospheric, subtly dark background. The artist: Henri-Arthur Bonnefoy was a pupil of Léon Cogniet and distinguished himself particularly for his
