Venetian painter (early 20th century) - Carnival in Venice, Piazza San Marco. 40.5 x 55 cm (without frame), 46.5 x 62 cm (with frame). Oil on canvas, in carved and gilded wooden frame. The composition depicts a carnival celebration in Piazza San Marco in Venice, set in a nocturnal or crepuscular light. The Campanile and the outline of the Basilica rise against a turquoise sky in the background. Numerous figures in eighteenth-century costume, ladies, gentlemen and masked revellers, are gathered around a central table, animated by a lively and unstudied movement. The brushwork is swift and loose, in an Impressionist vein, with a palette built on harmonies of green, ochre, wine red and white that lend the scene a sense of movement and atmosphere. The handling of the figures, barely
