The main composition, in the upper part, develops around a plant crown carved in relief, centered by a fleur-de-lys standing out against a scale background. The corners are embellished with floral motifs that harmoniously complete the whole. By the quality of its decoration and its excellent decorative character, this panel is a fine testimony to the furniture art of the late Middle Ages, a period of transition between the flamboyant Gothic and the early Renaissance
