Description

A refined and rare miniature painting from the first half of the 19th century (dating from around 1820 to 1830), depicting an elegant family group portrait in an interior setting. The work is stylistically attributed to the renowned Romanini workshop, known for its high-quality portraiture. The scene, rich in domestic intimacy in the full Biedermeier and Regency style, depicts four figures captured in a moment of understated intellectualism. On the left, a young woman sits at the fortepiano in front of a musical score, an element that underscores the family's high cultural level and love for the arts. Beside her, the male and female figures are portrayed with extraordinary miniaturist precision: the fine details of the faces, the updo typical of the era, the white lace-embroidered collars, and the
