### Description

Menpo - Shita bo, kuro nuri Menpo face mask in the me no shita bo style, Edo period (1603 - 1868) In the usual design with a removable nose piece, the surface is painted with black kuro nuri lacquer, the back of the mask is painted vermilion red. With shiwa wrinkles and a wick made of animal hair and hooks (kagi) for fixing the helmet chin strap (kabuto no o). The exposed stylized teeth of the open mouth of the mask are gold in color. The four-piece tare throat protection is in the kiritsuke style. This is a very characteristic variant of the face mask in very good condition. Stand is not included.
