The canvas depicts a gondola on the open lagoon at sunset, with a standing oarsman at the stern and four figures seated aboard. In the background, the profile of Venice is visible in the distance against a sky of dark clouds and warm light reflected on the water surface. The composition is frontally arranged, showing a good command of atmospheric values and crepuscular light on the lagoon. The painterly language belongs to the tradition of view painters active in Venice for the international market in the second half of the 19th century, with a
