Description

Rare 19th-century bakery corner shelf Wrought iron, brass and glass trays. Elegant and particularly rare in this corner configuration, this charming 19th-century bakery shelf seduces with its fine wrought-iron work and light silhouette. Originally designed to take its place in the corner of a boutique or refined interior, it bears witness to the decorative skills of late 19th-century iron craftsmen. The work is distinguished by a harmonious succession of delicately hand-forged scrolls and volutes, highlighted by brass motifs that bring warmth and elegance to the whole. The eye naturally follows the vertical slenderness of the structure, crowned by a graceful pediment with soft, airy lines. Corner models are much rarer today than traditional wall shelves, their specific design having limited their production. This

characteristic makes them a particularly sought-after piece, both for their decorative interest and for their functionality. At the time of its origins, the corner shelving was designed to be used as a decorative element. Originally designed to display breads and pastries, this shelf has been fitted with glass trays made in keeping with its aesthetic. This unobtrusive adaptation gives it a particularly pleasing contemporary use, allowing it to showcase porcelain, objets d'art, glassware, plants or various collections while retaining its authentic character. The marriage of iron and glass makes this shelving unit particularly attractive. The combination of patinated iron, brass and transparent glass creates a visually light ensemble. Its corner format also makes it possible to elegantly occupy an often neglected space, transforming a simple corner of a room into a genuine decorative element. Presented in a beautiful state of preservation, this shelf combines the charm of old French shops with the timeless elegance of 19th-century decorative furniture. A rare piece, refined and full of character, ideal in a mansion kitchen, conservatory, living room or decorating boutique where it will immediately add a touch of charm and authenticity.
