Description

A refined, architecturally inspired piece of furniture from the 17th-century Dutch Renaissance. Made of solid oak, it illustrates the rigorous geometry and sculptural depth characteristic of Northern European craftsmanship of the period. The front features two arched panels framed by fluted pilasters and dark inlays, creating a rhythmic play of light and shadow on the richly grained surface. Resting on turned legs, this piece of furniture of compact proportions conceals a majestic presence - a miniature echo of Renaissance architecture, transposed in wood. Inside, a single shelf divides the space for practical storage, while the original fittings and lock retain their historic integrity. Carefully restored, the cabinet bears witness to the meticulous preservation of its warm patina
