Small CARQUOIS made of braided fibers with used for hunting Kayapo Indians, states of Pará and Mato Grosso, Rio Xingu valley, northern Brazil. Wood, fiber and cotton. H. 28; L. 10.5 cm (signs of use). Tossed with a blowpipe, the darts were used to paralyze small game thanks to the curare - a substance derived from lianas - in which the tip was dipped.
