Description

Jean-Pierre BLANCHE(1927-2022) La plage de Guyotville en Algérie, 1957, gouache, 25 x 33 cm, located in Guyotville, dated 57 and signed lower right. Dimensions framed 41 x 48 cm. Before Provence, his field of experimentation was Algeria, where, winner of the Abd-el-Tif prize in 1955, he stayed for two years when he wasn't even thirty. He discovered the Maghreb, Algiers, Oran and Bône, and was fascinated by the Sahara. The landscapes - more rarely the portraits - he brought back are astonishingly diverse, reflecting the multiple research of an artist with no constraints. Sometimes treated in a distinctly "fauve" vein, they can just as easily display a cameo of muted ochres and blues, a far cry from the dazzlement experienced by so many painters discovering the Maghreb, from Delacroix
