



## Bracelet Early 19th Century Carved Coral And Pomponne

### Description

This beautiful bracelet features 11 threaded balls in the pineapple-cut coral gradation characteristic of Georgian and early Victorian jewelry, spaced with diabolo-like spacers of softly gilded pomponne-pinchbeck. The ratchet-style clasp is concealed in a ball engraved with pomponne-pinchbeck scrolls. Two rings welded to the nearest spacers allow a safety chain to be added. Excellent condition of the red coral, well-functioning clasp, dense jewel in hand. Beware, for small wrists! PERFECT CONDITION, England Georgian period circa 1820-1830. Open length 18cm, fits a wrist with a circumference of 15.5cm Weight 32g
