Description

The piece certainly shows visible signs of wear, which is precisely what makes it so charming. A wide cotton band has been sewn on all the ends, as well as on part of the central field. This is a sacred Yörük rug from the Konya region of central Anatolia. Wool-on-wool knotted-stitch technique. The velvet is short, reminiscent of ancient Caucasian productions. The Tree of Life motif can be clearly seen in the central field, along with numerous stylized floral motifs. Vegetal hues of great purity. The chromatic palette is very harmonious, with here and there the seductive presence of a magnificent pale indigo blue. Through this beautiful patina, a highly refined decorative ensemble emerges. The piece's authenticity and age are immediately apparent. Similarly, the fine, supple texture is
