Description

Spanish-style "A VOILE" dagger, XVIII°, early XIX°. Fused-iron frame in the form of a shuttle filigree in herringbone steel ending in two braids of steel wire forming terminal ferrules. Fused-iron top with spiral decoration and prominent rivet knob. Flat-backed, grooved blade 42 cm long and pointed counter-edge 15 cm. Flat-backed, grooved pommel with spiral decoration and prominent rivet knob. Flat-backed, grooved pommel with spiral decoration and prominent rivet knob. Strong hand protection fr voile type running from pommel to quillon with hemmed edge. Flat-backed, grooved blade 42 cm long and pointed counteredge 15 cm. Large ricasso at heel, pierced with 5 holes and 2 different stylized signs. Blade with engraving remnant on 2 sides partly erased, see photos. 2 straight steel guard
