A glazed ceramic tile featuring "Las Guitarras - The Spanish Guitars" after Salvador Dali (1904-1989) Published by Maurice Duchin, in 1954 in Spain, with the authorization and under the control of the artist. Mention on back, numbered on edge. Small chips on edges (photo). Period: mid XXth. Dimensions : 20 x 20 cm, thickness 9 mm. Good condition. This glazed ceramic painted and signed on the plate by Salvador Dalí, belongs to a limited edition of six ceramics celebrating Dali's attachment to the Catalogne through designs evoking essential themes: "Le soleil végétal" for life, "The starfish" for death, "The darts" for war, "The doves" for peace, "The guitars" for musician's life, "The fire" for love.
