Three drawer boxes full of compartments, each containing a tiny glass container closed by a metal stopper. You could keep millions of diamonds in them, for less than ruby or any other collectible but initially, these flasks held tiny timepieces created by Rudolf Fume in Berlin. You can read the nomenclature for, say, "W" winding rods for Swiss wristwatches. There are 100 vials per case and 11 drawers...each glass measures 1 cm x 22mm high. I chose the scientific instruments section because watchmaking is a science... just like jewelry.
