Moroccan child's dagger called koumya, silver and horn - Morocco, 1894-95 Rare child's model of small dimensions. Horn handle with chased silver pommel and ferrule. Chased silver scabbard. 2 silver certification marks on the scabbard, reading 312 and MO.312 for the date 1312 of the Hegira calendar, corresponding to the years 1894 and 1895 of the Gregorian calendar. Petty dents to the silver of the pommel and to the bottom of the scabbard. Accents to the horn. Handle has some play. Slightly deformed blade. Length 23cm Length without scabbard 21,5cm Blade length 11cm Weight 130gr Weight without scabbard 82gr scabbard weight 48gr
