Suite of six colorless blown glass spirit flasks, the rectangular bodies with cut sides and rounded shoulders, closed with screw caps and inner corks with silver-plated metal gadrooned mounts. Original case in rosewood and veneer, bronze keyhole and handle. XVIIIth century. Condition of use. Body in good condition (lateral chips on two, impurities and air bubbles in the material), screw threads and stoppers with small chips or laces, one stopper pierced. Case with accidents and missing veneer, missing side grips, green felt and silk interior in poor condition. Bottle heights : 17.1 to 17.5 cm Case: Height. : 24.5 cm - Width: 31.5 cm - Depth: 18 cm
